**PRIZES AND AWARDS**

A qualifying score is required for all ribbons. Dark green qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Rosettes will be awarded for those finishing a title. Green Rosettes will be awarded to Double Qualifiers in Ex B only. MACH & PACH bars and Titling Rosettes will be given to those obtaining a MACH or PACH at this trial. All awards and prizes must be claimed the day of the trial - none will be mailed.

**DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

These trials are open to all dogs 15 months of age or over that are registered with the AKC, or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved

Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical performance +++are not eligible to enter.

**MOVE-UPS**

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary not later than 6PM, Monday, March 9, 2021

Move ups for Sunday, March 14, 2021, must be submitted no later than ¼ hour following the posting of results from the class moving up from. Forms will be available at the trial site.

**Please Note:** Dogs having attained their first AKC Agility Title (Std or JWW) must be moved to the Nov B class (Std or JWW) for all trials for which entries have not closed. If entries have already closed on the date the dog obtained its title, the dog shall remain in the class in which it was originally entered or be moved up in level (i.e. Novice to Open) at the request of the owner; subject to the move-up criteria, except as stated in Chapter 1, Sections 21 regarding Novice A entries. (as stated below)

Section 21 - A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or the handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to a Novice "B" class.

**WAIT LIST**

Saguaro Scramblers is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials closing date. A Maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 6pm, March 6, 2021. Any entries withdrawn that are received by noon March 10, 2021 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by noon March 10, 2021 will receive a full refund

**Simplified Jump Height Card Process**

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

**How do I know if I have a valid jump height card?**

**If your dog is under the age of two years as of the trial's date:** One (1) temporary measurement is required. Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow copy, other wise your dog needs to be measured. If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date,

your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

**If your dog is the age of two years or older as of the trial's date:** A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required. If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card. If not, then a third measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. Until such time that you have received all required measurements for a permanent jump height card, check the "My dog needs to be measured" box. Upon arrival at the trial, you must check to see if there is a Volunteer Measuring Official and/or an Agility Field Rep. present to perform official measurements. If not, and you possess a yellow copy of the Agility Measurement Form from a previous measurement, then your armband may be picked up during Check-In in lieu of being measured by the judge of record.

**Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement:** If your dog measures over 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the "Over 22" Request Perm" box at the bottom of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement. If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox. By doing so, you are giving up your right to have a 2nd measurement performed on your dog in the future; however, you are not giving up your right to have the challenge measurement process performed in the future

**What if my dog measures into a different jump height then what he is entered?**

If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of completing the challenge measurement process. Dogs who measure into a higher jump height have always been required to be moved immediately.

**May I challenge my dog's jump height card measurement?**  
Yes, each dog may go through the challenge process once after the age of two (2) years, if requested by the owner. (Any dogs under the age of two (2) years are also eligible for a challenge measurement.)

**What is the jump height card challenge process?**  
The jump height card challenge process replicates the original measurement steps. A minimum of two (2) challenge measurements are required. If both challenge measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, then you will be issued a new permanent card from the AKC office. If the two challenge measurements place the dog in different jump height classes, then a third challenge measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. When the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> measurement is completed in the challenge measurement process, the new measurement is effective immediately.

**It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.**

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure any dog they believe might belong in a different division, and dog whose entry in a given division might be questioned. In the Preferred Classes handlers must jump the height called for and may not jump higher.

#### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

**The safety of the dogs** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the AKC rules and regulations for this sport, and that their dogs are able to perform all of the obstacles safely.

**Entries must reach** the Trial Secretary no later than 6pm, March 6, 2021, but not before 8AM January 28, 2021. Fees must accompany entries and be paid in U.S. currency, **Payable to Saguaro Scramblers Agility Club, Inc.**

**NSF Checks** that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution will be assessed a service charge of \$20 per incident.

**Entries without** the AKC agreement on the back are not acceptable. Incomplete or illegible entries are not acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial (AKC Rules, Ch 14, Sec 4). Please indicate the dog's handler if the dog is co-owned or the handler is different than the owner. *Returned checks* will be charged a collection fee and will not constitute a valid entry.

**Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Entry fees will not be refunded, if the trial cannot open or be completed due to acts beyond the control of the management.

**Entry fees will be refunded** for bitches coming into season, or illness or injury (or death) to a dog after the closing date. A refund of \$13.00 per run entered will be made upon receipt of veterinarian certification. Request must be made prior to end of trial and accompanied by the veterinarian certificate at that time.

**Exhibitors alone are responsible** for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. There will be no refund of entry fees for exhibitors that are asked to leave the trial site due to their dogs or children creating unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engaging in unsafe behavior.

**The judging will start promptly.** During the hours of judging, owners are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for the judging of their class. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused.

**Exhibitor's confirmation** of entry will be *mailed or e-mailed* to the address given on the entry form and should be mailed/e-mailed no later than 7 days prior to the trial. Exhibitors not receiving a confirmation should notify the Trial Secretary.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup>** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

# Saguaro Scramblers COVID-19 Rules, Recommendations and Waiver

(You must sign and return with trial entry)

## COVID-19 Rules

**Saguaro Scramblers USDAA COVID-19 rules have been developed to maintain compliance with current Kino Sports Complex requirements (a Pima County Facility) as well as current CDC recommendations.**

Kino Sports Complex limits gatherings to a total of 50 people per day. Non-volunteering non-competing guests and spectators are not allowed at this trial with the exception that a guest may come briefly in the morning to help set up your canopy and pack up at the end of the trial. Volunteering non-competing guests are allowed if they volunteer at least 3 classes per day and must be declared in advance on this form or by emailing the trial secretary and will be included in the 50-person limit.

**FACE COVERING/MASKS** covering both the mouth and nose are required to be worn when an individual cannot maintain a continuous distance of 6' from other individuals. However, individuals traveling together are exempted from this rule when near only each other.

Specifically, face coverings are required during walk-thrus, briefings, during volunteering if continuous social distancing is not possible, in restrooms, near score/secretary tables, and while in designated high traffic area in front of rings. Masks must be worn when approaching another competitor, trial committee, volunteers, or judge unless properly socially distancing.

Face coverings are not required while running your dog in the ring, in your canopy, or while walking around (other than in the marked high traffic area in front of the ring entrances) provided you maintain social distancing.

Disposable masks will be available at the trial for anyone who needs one. Masks are the preferred face covering, but gaiters and bandanas are also acceptable as long as they cover both the mouth and nose. **Face shields are only acceptable when combined with a mask that covers both mouth and nose.**

**CANOPIES:** Canopies and tents are to be set up with 12' of space in between them. (As stated above, individuals traveling together do not need to wear a mask when together, so a mask is not required while utilizing canopies/tents, unless entering the tent of someone not in your party.)

**RULES FOR WORKERS:** If volunteering in a job where you cannot maintain at least 6' of continuous social distancing, you are required to wear a mask.

**LEASH RUNNING:** Leash runners will use a sanitized "grabber" to pick up and carry leashes and wear a mask unless they can continuously maintain a distance of 6' from other people.

Failure to comply will initially result in a reminder of the rules.

**Deliberate refusal to comply with these COVID-19 rules will result in expulsion from the trial and that individual must leave the facility immediately with no refund given.**

## COVID-19 Safety Recommendations and Precautions

- Hospitality will not be provided at this trial, other than water bottles. Please bring your own food and refreshments.

- Please be aware of items that you touch that may have been touched or will be touched by others (e.g., either wear gloves or sanitize hands immediately before and after if you are touching things that are touched by others)

- Avoid touching your face.

- Wash your hands often with soap and water and/or use hand sanitizers (gels, wipes, etc.); please bring your own to assure availability.

- Restrooms are single occupancy and hand sanitizer and soap will be provided.

**If you are concerned about the possibility of exposure to the coronavirus OR if you are unwilling to follow the stated rules, it would be better if you did not enter this trial.**

## Waiver

I agree that if I am diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of the first day of the trial, I will not attend, and can contact the trial secretary for a refund.

I agree to not attend the trial if I am exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, including but not limited to cough, sore throat, fever, and shortness of breath, or have been knowingly exposed to COVID-19 within 14 days of the trial.
